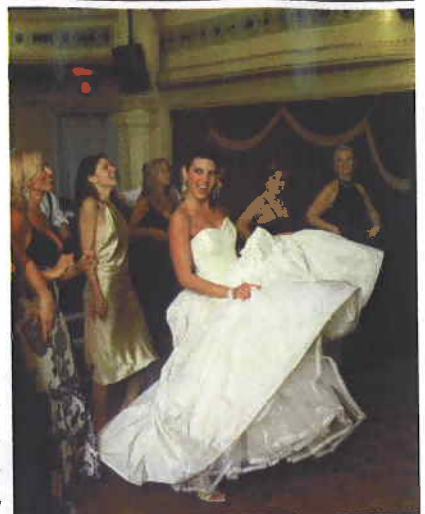


Katherine Vigna & Leonard Krol

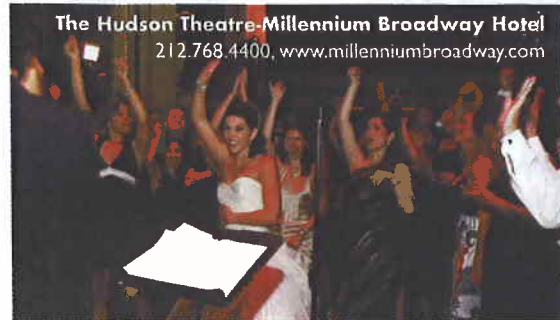

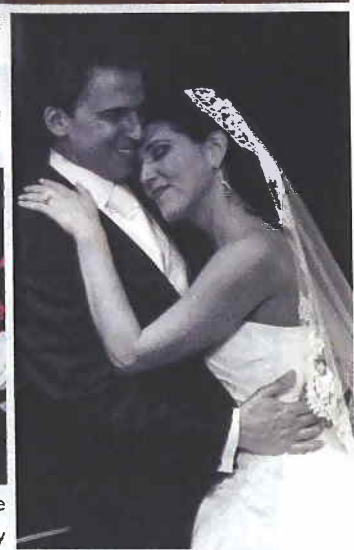
